
Spider fly



Step 1. Start your thread at the hook point and wrap back to the hook barb.

Step 2. Tie in some lead wire at the back of the hook. Wrap the lead forward about 5-8 wraps, then wrap back over toward the back making a football shape. You should end your wraps in the front. Secure the lead with a few wraps of thread.

Step 3. Tie in some chenille at the back of the lead. Wrap the chenille forward making sure to cover all the lead. Tie the chenille in right behind the hook eye.

Step 4. Take a piece of round rubber leg measuring about 2" when folded in half. Holding the legs on the top of the hook by the eye, secure with a couple of loose wraps. Fold the rubber leg look back over the fly and secure with tight wraps. Make a small thread head on the fly and whip finish or tie off.

Step 5. Cut the rubber leg loop and pull the legs out so they fan out over the front of the fly. Secure the thread wraps with home head cement.
