## Flashback Pheasant Tail

## List of materials

**HOOK:** straight shank hook size #10, #12. #14, #16. **THREAD:** UTC 70 dark brown or color of your choice.

**BODY:** Pheasant Tail, thin wire, pearl flash strip, peacock herl. **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS:** Copper color bead, lead-free wire.

## **Steps**




Put the bead on the hook with the large end facing the back. Wrap a small amount of lead-free wire behind the bead and push into the large opening of the bead.





Start the thread behind the lead-free wire. Wrap to the back of the hook and over the lead-free wire, securing it in place. Tie in a piece of thin wire on the side of the hook facing you.



Select half a dozen pheasant fibers from the stiff end of the feather. Tie them in with the tips extending out the back of the hook. The length should be about  $\frac{1}{3}$  the length of the hook. Do one or two wraps of thread behind the fibers.







Pull the butt-end of the feather fibers forward, splitting the tips in half. Pull the flash strip forward and tie it right behind the bead.



Tie off the thread or whip finish the fly.
