

## Demon variant

### List of materials





**HOOK:** 3/0 (or your choice)

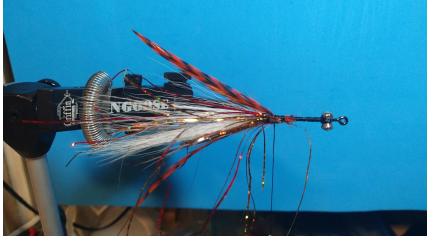
**THREAD:** UTC 140 color of your choice.

**BODY:** rabbit strip, bucktail, flashabou, hackle feathers, and craft fur

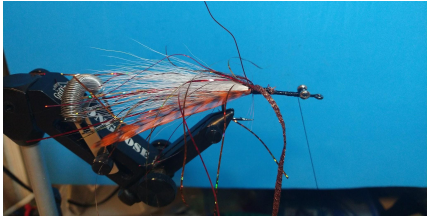
### Steps



	<p>Start by covering the hook shank in the thread. Advance your thread to the front and tie in a set of dumbbell eyes or large bead chain eyes.</p>
	<p>Tie in some flash on the back of the hook. Fold over and secure tightly.</p>
	<p>Tie in a small bunch of bucktail. It should extend about 1 look length behind the bend. Make sure the bucktail goes all around the hook.</p>
	<p>Tie in another bunch of flash and fold over the bucktail. Make sure it spreads out over the top.</p>



Tie in two hackle feathers. Make sure they curve to the outside. This will give more action in the water.



Tie in a wire and chenille (or body wrap with flash). The wire will be used to hold down the rabbit strip in the next step.



Cut a piece of rabbit strip zonker (or other animal zonker strip, like raccoon or fox). The strip should extend from behind the dumbbell eyes to most of the way over the bucktail (but not all). Tie it in at the back (where all of the other materials have been tied in). Make sure to use a bodkin to split the hair fibers and not tie them down. Lift the strip up and advance your thread to just behind the eyes. Wrap the chenille or body wrap forward and secure. Lay the strip over the top and secure it right behind the eyes.



Carefully wrap the wire over the strip and secure it to the hook shank. Use your bodkin to pick the fibers out of the way. Wrap up to the eyes and secure.



Tie in two more feathers on each side of the hook, the same as the first ones.

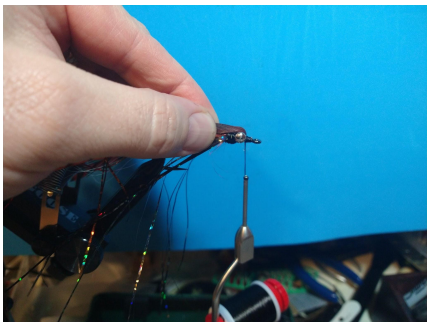


(Missing: tie in another bunch of flash and fold back over the rabbit strip.)

Tie in another strip of rabbit strip. This one should be about  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1 hook length. Tie it in right in front of the eyes.



Pull up this strip and put a dab of superglue in between the eyes.



Fold the strip back and hold it in place.



Tie in a small bunch of red or orange rabbit strip on the bottom to make a throat. Alternatively, you could use craft fur or flash.



Alternatively, you can add a small bunch of craft fur and use that as the throat and in front of the eye to make a larger head. (The craft fur actually matches the color of the rabbit strip here).



This can be tied in a variety of colors as well.
